

# EDUCATION AND TRAINING VOUCHER (ETV)



## What is ETV?

ETV is a DHS scholarship that awards up to \$5,000 per academic school year. It can be used to pay for things like:

- Tuition
- Books
- Fees
- Room and Board
- Transportation
- Supplies

## Who is eligible for the ETV program?

- Youth who entered a guardianship or adoption through DHS after the age of 16
- Youth who left DHS custody on or after their 18th birthday
- Youth who were in DHS custody for nine months or more between the ages of 16 and 18
- Youth who were in the custody of another state may be eligible if they meet the above requirements

## Where can the ETV scholarship be used?

The ETV scholarship can be used at 2 or 4 year colleges, universities, or technical schools.
